



MPH 2019 STREET LEGAL GRUDGE DRAG RACING RULES

STREET LEGAL RULES WILL APPLY AND GOVERN THE EVENTS AT MPH

NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OR GLASS CONTAINERS PERMITTED AT ANY TIME
IN THE HOT PITS!

Basic Technical Requirements

Vehicle must have current vehicle registration and valid plates; driver's license and a valid proof of insurance (**must have all documentation with you at time of registration**). Cars can be brought into the speedway on trailers. .

Cost - \$5.00 per person to enter the Facility with signed appropriate waiver (Green Wristband)
\$25.00 to race your vehicle plus additional signed appropriate waiver (Red Wristband)

Under 18

No one less than 18 years of age may participate. No One under 18 may enter the facility without the appropriate Minor Waiver form completed.

10-Second Rule

We have a 10-second flat ¼ Mile ET rule. No cars quicker than 10 seconds will be allowed to race. (If you need a Competition License to drive your car at a Drag Strip, it is too quick for the MPH Street Legal events

Electronics

No aftermarket electronic devices allowed (throttle stops, delay boxes, etc.)

Exhaust

must be routed through muffler(s). All runs may be monitored on a decibel meter (105db at 50' from the strip). If it is too loud you will not be allowed to run again until corrected. NO EXCEPTIONS! It is your responsibility and management may disqualify you at any time with no refund.

Tires

Street legal DOT approved tires front and DOT or Non-DOT Drag Slicks allowed on Rear of Car with drive shaft loop mandatory. No Burnouts allowed.

Wheels

all wheel studs, with lug nuts required. Broken or missing studs/lugs must be replaced before racing. Hub caps/wheel covers must be removed to race.

Lines & Hoses

all fuel, transmission, brake and power steering lines must be secure and free of leaks. Neoprene fuel lines limited to 12" overall. No water, fuel, oil or transmission leaks

Radiator

Overflow catch tank (12 oz. minimum) mandatory on all vehicles and no leaks allowed.

Driver:

You must present a valid USA driver's license and be 18 years of age or older. No shorts, bare legs, tank tops, bare torsos, or bare feet permitted when racing.

Passengers: NO Passengers allowed during side-by-side grudge racing.

Helmet

required for all Drivers. In 2019 your helmet must meet **SNELL SA or SM 2010** or better standards (must have label inside of helmet). In 2017 this changed to SA or SM 2010 or newer. We have approved helmets available for \$10 and leaving your drivers license in registration for the event. Limited availability please register early.

Seats

must be securely fastened to floor or frame with minimum 4 attaching bolt and nuts. No sheet metal screws.

Seat Belts

all cars and trucks must have as a minimum an O.E.M. type lap belt system, securely mounted to frame or floor.

Batteries & Ballast

Batteries must be secured per O.E.M. (No straps, bungee cords, wire, etc). Loose ballast is not permitted on the racetrack, so be prepared to empty trunks and interiors of all loose items. Spare tires, jacks, etc. must be securely mounted or must be removed. Tools, jack stands, coolers, loose speakers, wheel covers, etc. are considered loose ballast and are not permitted on the track. If you don't need it, or don't want to leave it unattended, leave it at home.

Neutral Safety Switch

all vehicles must be equipped with an operational neutral safety switch. The neutral safety switch prevents the vehicle's starter from turning the engine over unless the transmission is in park or neutral (or unless the clutch pedal is depressed with a manual transmission).

Nitrous Oxide

NOS – is allowed in 2019 - tanks must be secure in trunk or safely installed with appropriate safety devices in place.

Roll Bars & Cages

All Convertibles must have roll over protection capable of supporting the vehicle. Approved Convertibles must meet the **Seat Belts** requirements above.

Motorcycles

No Bikes.

Tech Inspection

Vehicles must comply with all guidelines listed then a number will be assigned to the vehicle and driver.

Hear the Call

PA announcements. Please have all safety items in place, helmet and seat belts on. Also, leave all loose items out of the vehicle. You must have your wristband on and visible as you pass through the pit area.

Staging Lanes

When you are called to the lanes go to the back of the staging lanes. We offer Street Stock and Street Modified classes.

Burn-Out/Staging

Absolutely **No burn-outs are permitted anywhere on the facility**. On the starting line official's signal, roll your car forward until you are staged. And then STOP. DO NOT DO A BURN OUT or you will be **immediately DISQUALIFIED**. You are now staged and ready. When the both cars are staged correctly the Light will go from Yellow to Green and you may start the race. Do not leave before the green light or you will "red-light" and automatically are disqualified from that round. The race is over at the finish line marked on the Track just below the Green Light.

Finish Line

After crossing the finish line let off the gas slowly and then apply your brakes. Stay in your lane until you exit around the left turn at the end of the track. The left lane will exit first even though you may have to wait on them if you are in the right lane. DO NOT DO A U-TURN ON THE TRACK.

AMBULANCE

MPH will have an ALS Medic at the track during racing hours. Medic is staged at gate 2 where you enter the track.

Quiet Please

In our continued efforts to be good neighbors, we will be enforcing our zero-tolerance policy for decimeter readings over the limit. Please also be considerate of what our neighbors think of us when leaving the facility. Please do not race away from the facility when you leave. Drive Safely!!
